



2026 PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Monarch Research, in partnership with local Hy-Vee stores, ImOn Communications, Indian Creek Nature Center, and iHeartRadio, invites families to join **One Child, One Tree™ — Growing Together!** Through this exciting habitat restoration initiative, parents and grandparents can receive **up to five free native trees for the children or grandchildren in their family**— helping Linn County's children grow a lifelong connection to nature, *one tree at a time*.

HOW IT WORKS

Follow these easy steps to reserve your child or grandchild's tree!



TREE ORDERING INFORMATION

- 1** Pick up a tree certificate at participating HyVee stores, ImOn Communications, or Indian Creek Nature Center; certificates are located at the customer service counter inside HyVee stores, at the front desk at ImOn Communications, or at the front entrance information desk at Indian Creek. Your certificate will allow you to order up to five trees for the children or grandchildren in your family; **one certificate per family is permitted.**

- 2** You must have a certificate to order trees for your children or grandchildren. Your certificate has a unique Order Code that is required to complete the online order form.

- 3** Order your child or grandchild's tree online: Scan the QR Code on your certificate to access the online order form, or visit monarchresearch.org. Follow the steps to complete and submit your order.

- 4** There is no expiration on your certificate. You may order your tree at any time; trees are available while supplies last. Tree quantities are limited by species—once a species is sold out, it will no longer be available for selection. **Order deadline is July 24, 2026.**

- 5** Review available tree species: Access and download the *Tree Species* document from the online order form to view information on available tree species. This document will help you determine the appropriate tree for your planting space.

- 6** Order Confirmation: Once you have successfully completed and submitted your order, you will receive an email confirmation.

Tree Pickup: Tree pickup will be in **early October**. Details about pickup time and location will be shared at a later date.
