HOW IT WORKS: ONLY 6 EASY STEPS!

- Free Trees for Employees: Organizations partner with Monarch Research to provide high-quality native trees to their employees at no cost.
- **Employee Commitment:** Employees commit to learning about native trees and participating in the program.
- **Tree Selection:** Each participant selects up to 3 native trees (including one oak) from a provided species list.
- **Online Ordering:** Participants place their tree orders online and receive a confirmation.
- **Tree Pickup:** Participants pick up their trees from a designated location.
- **Tree Care:** Participants become "Tree Ambassadors" by planting, watering, and caring for their trees.

WHY IT MATTERS

The 2020 derecho devastated our community. In response, we've planted 100,000 native trees, restoring vital habitats on public and private lands throughout Linn County. However, much work remains.
