# PLANTING FORWARD *for* WOODLANDS

A Monarch Research Native Tree Restoration Initiative 

Monarch Research, with support of generous private donors, have made the Planting Forward programs possible. For the Woodlands, landowners choose from 30 native tree species, purchased at our wholesale cost of \$25 for 3-gallon and \$50 for 7-gallon. Trees arrive in mid-October and are 3-6 feet tall.

**Minimum order of 5 trees - maximum order of 150 trees.**

**Pickup at 4970 Lakeside Road, Marion, IA - delivery optional at \$75 (minimum order of 25 trees).**

## HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

- ❑ **Visit the Monarch Research Website** at [monarchresearch.org](https://monarchresearch.org) to download the species selection PDF, review program details, and place an order.
- ❑ **Review Available Species Selections** - The Fall 2023 program offers a selection of 30 species of high-quality, native trees. Landowners interested in participating in the program should review species options available online under [Resources](#) before ordering. Protective deer fencing is also available on the order form.
- ❑ **Consider Oak Trees** – the importance of native Iowa Oak trees cannot be overstated. This keystone tree provides food for hundreds of species, pollinators, birds, and other wildlife. - ❑ **Share this Information** - If you are ordering as a repeat participant and need fewer, you may want to consider combining your order with a friend, neighbor, or family member.
- ❑ **Limited Quantity** - Landowners may purchase a minimum order of 5 trees and a maximum of 150 trees. **Order early to assure selections are available!!**
- ❑ **Don't Delay** - **Online ordering begins Monday, August 7 at 7:00 am** and will continue until Saturday, August 26 at 5:00 pm, *while quantities last.*

- ❑ **Planting and Care** – this is a critical part of the program's success. Planting, Care, and Tips are available on the website and will be handed out during tree pickup. *Note: It's easier to kill a tree, than to plant it correctly from the beginning.*
